# Baby Moses by the River

## Parent Handout

This week, kids learned in Exodus 1:8–2:10 that God protected Moses when he was a baby. The Egyptian king had ordered that all baby boys must die. To save baby Moses, his mother put him in a basket by the river. The king’s daughter came down to bathe in the river and heard the baby’s cries. She rescued Moses and allowed his mother to nurse him until he was weaned. God rescued Moses because of His care and protection.

“When the child grew older, she took him to Pharaoh’s daughter and he became her son. She named him Moses, saying, ‘I drew him out of the water.’” Exodus 2:10
